Signing of Collaboration Protocol between Ghabbour Foundation and the Ministry of Education

HE Dr. Tarek Shawki attended on February 15th 2021, the signing ceremony of the collaboration protocol between Ghabbour Foundation for Development and the Ministry of Education officiating the launch of Ghabbour-1 and Ghabbour-2 Applied Technology Schools in May 15th and 6th October cities for the academic year 2021 -2022 in the presence of Dr. Raouf Ghabbour, Chairman of Ghabbour Foundation and of GB Auto.

The protocol was signed by Dr. Mohamed Megahed, Deputy Minister of Education for Technical Education and Eng. George Sedky, Secretary General, Ghabbour Foundation and Chief Human Resources Officer, GB Auto in presence of Dr. Amr Bossila, Head of Applied Technology Schools and Director of the Central Authority for Development of Vocational Education, Ministry officials and representatives of Ghabbour Foundation, SIS ME and the German Arab Chamber of Industry & Commerce (AHK)

The agreement falls within the framework of the new vocational education system 2.0 which aims to involve industry in fulfilling the requirements of the demands of the local and international markets as well as establishing the adequate balance between education based on working and learning hand-in-hand towards qualifying highly competitive students with enhanced personal and technical skills. That model is adopted in Applied Technology Schools. It also falls in line with Ghabbour Foundation's objective to develop the ecosystem of vocational education and boost employability matching with the demands of economic and social development national plans while also working on the enhancement of the general perception about vocational education.










Ghabbour Foundation Collaborates with Goethe-Institute and Ideas Gym to Provide Arduino Courses to Students from Imbaba, Kafr El-Zayat and Moharram Bek Schools

With the purpose of providing students with an opportunity to enhance their IT skills and get better prepared for the rapidly evolving technologies, Ghabbour Foundation collaborated with Goethe-Institut and Ideas Gym to introduce Arduino courses that best complement the students' educational journey.

Arduino Level 1 course covers basic concepts of controlling circuits projects as well as the basics of designing and c-programming. It eases the students' technical knowledge and practices by allowing them to program their own micro-controllers. On a more advanced level, Arduino paves the future for students who are interested to join the Future Engineering in World Robot Olympiad Association; one of the world's leading association that promotes robotics in STEM education worldwide and inspire youth to be digital pioneers.





Protocol of Agreement with Hamed El Shiaty Foundation and Starchem Trade

In June 2021, Ghabbour Foundation signed a protocol of collaboration with Hamed El-Shiaty Foundation and Starchem Trade, by which El-Shiaty Foundation contributes to the cost of education and training of 22 students in the Automotive Paint Specialization in the two new Applied Technology schools developed by the Foundation in 6th October and May 15th for the full duration of their studies. In addition, Starchem Trade contributes with training materials and tools required by the students in that specialization.

The agreement stems from El-Shiaty Foundation's commitment to supporting education, out of its belief in its crucial role in developing the community as a whole, contributing to the overall welfare of the nation as well as Starchem's prominent role in promoting job opportunities for youth in the highly demanded Automotive Paint sector.























Career Day for Graduating Students

In April 2021, Ghabbour Foundation organized its second annual Career Day for graduating students. Two consecutive events were organized in Alexandria, for graduating students of Kafr El-Zayat and Moharam Bek schools, and in Cairo for Imbaba School.

Representatives of top automotive companies, including: Nissan, Mercedes-Benz, El-Kasrawy, Ssangyong, Al-Tahan, Al-Wahab, in addition to GB Auto and GB Polo were invited and met with prospective candidates to assess their personal and technical skills. Between the two events, 260 students presented their CVs and underwent rotational rounds of individual interviews.

Feedback received from interviewers reflected of the outstanding qualifications of the school graduates.




Developing the New Ministry of Education Applied Technology Schools

Consistent with its wholesome development approach adopted since 2017, Ghabbour Foundation initiated the development of the new Applied Technology Schools in May 15th and 6th October cities in the month of April, focusing on enhancement of infrastructure, facilities, building of new workshops, introduction of state-of-the-art machinery and tools in workshops to meet with the German and industry standards, in addition to equipping classrooms with advanced teaching tools to provide an enhanced teaching and learning environment. The Foundation has also worked closely with the Ministry on the recruitment, selection and training of the schools' task force from the qualified pool of Ministry of Education and Technical Education's teachers and administrators as well as new recruits from faculties of Engineering to teach practical subjects.



With the beginning of the new academic year, Ghabbour Foundation proudly launched the opening of the new Applied Technology Schools developed by the Foundation in collaboration with the Ministry of Education and Technical Education. The new schools have opened their gates to 475 students in total, including over 60 girls along with a substantial representation of students from governorates. Students are getting introduced to the new school system and to the technical topics in automotive studies, while taking their first steps towards becoming tomorrow's outstandingly skilled calibers.

New Schools **Admissions**


In August 2021, Ghabbour Foundation started receiving student applications for the 2 new schools in May 15th and 6th October Cities through the Ministry of Education Portal. Over 7400 applications were received, 1000 admission tests administered over three phases: Theoretical tests, practical tests and personal interviews.

Accepted applicants were short-listed to reach the full capacity of each school: 225 students in 6th October school and 250 in May 15th.

Graduation of the Second Class of Ghabbour Foundation Students

In November 2021, Ghabbour Foundation marked a second major milestone as it celebrated the graduation of its second class of Imbaba students and first class from Muharam Bek and Kafr El Zayat following their development by Ghabbour Foundation starting 2017 and 2018 respectively., totaling around 250 vocational trainees.

The Ceremony was attended by General Khaled Abou Mandour, Head of the Productivity and Vocational Training Department (PVTD) from the Ministry of Trade & Industry, Eng. George Sedky, Secretary General of the Foundation and Chief Human Resources Officer for GB Auto, members of the Foundation and PVTD management and school teams and representatives of the Foundation's collaborators from SIS ME, the German Arab Chamber of Industry & Commerce (AHK) as well as the Foundation's long-standing partners and supporters: Starchem Trade, El Shiaty Foundation and Banque Misr Foundation for Community Development and of the Ceremony sponsor: ExxonMobil Egypt . Body and Paint Specializations Orientation Sessions

As the Foundation's first year students were getting more settled into their new academic year, an orientation session for Body and Paint Specializations was organized in both Ghabbour School-1 and Ghabbour School-2 by which students were introduced to these two vital specializations through a specialized panel involving Starchem's Technical Training Manager as well as Workshop/Service Managers from GB Auto and Al-Mansour Automotive, in addition to the Schools' Management.

The purpose of the session is to familiarize the students with the different study options and corresponding career choices in order to provide them with reliable tools to make informed decisions of their future.








El Mikaneeky Franchise Opportunity

Ghabbour Foundation, together with El Mikaneeky (a company established by partnership between GB Auto and Wahdan Auto Group specialized in quick service of multi-brand passenger vehicles), launched a new franchise program targeting graduates of vocational schools. The program provides them with the required training, orientation, counselling and job shadowing during one to two years in GB Auto / El Mikaneeky Service centers for the different job functions associated with running a service center, to prepare them for the big leap towards establishing their own franchise start-ups.

During the one-to-two-year preparatory period, applicants are assessed to determine those with actual potential to take on this endeavor. Through association with El Mikneeky's German Partner Boch, eligible candidates receive specialized training and guidance. In addition, GB Auto, through its affiliated companies provides funding support in the form of facilitated loans with minimum interest during the first 3 years of operation to help them in the initial set-up of the workshops.
